

7. Cut out the top of the face and score and slip in place.
Stretch the sides to fit around the edge



10. Choose your ear shape and cut 2. Turn 1 over so you have a pair. Mark the inner ear if you wish



8. Blend the clay around the sides and top



11. Score and slip your ears in place. Secure with extra clay at the back if needed



9. Seal the joins with a damp paint brush



12. Flatten a ball of clay to make a nose and score and slip to attach
