Cutters For Clay

1. Roll out your clay to 7mm thick and smooth out



2. Dust your mould with talc



3. Drape your clay over the mould. Smooth the clay around the mould



4. Place the cutter over the mould and press down to cut through the clay



5. Press the mould and clay up through the cutter



6. Turn over and smooth the edges of your clay





7. Cut out the top of the face and score and slip in place. Stretch the sides to fit around the edge



8. Blend the clay around the sides and top



9. Seal the joints with a damp paint brush



10. Choose your ear shape and cut 2. Turn 1 over so you have a pair. Mark the inner ear if you wish



11. Score and slip your ears in place. Secure with extra clay at the back if needed



12. Flatten a ball of clay to make a nose and score and slip to attach





13. Use the smallest ear cutter and cut a shape. Remove the cutter from the clay, move down slightly and cut again to create a crescent shape for the eye. Make two



14. Score and slip the eyes in place



15. Roll small balls of clay and flatten to make checks. Score and slip in place



16. All done! Flip over the face into the palm of your hand and remove the mould so your face can dry evenly. Add a hook if you'd like
