



Make a Gingerbread House with me...

Cutters For Clay

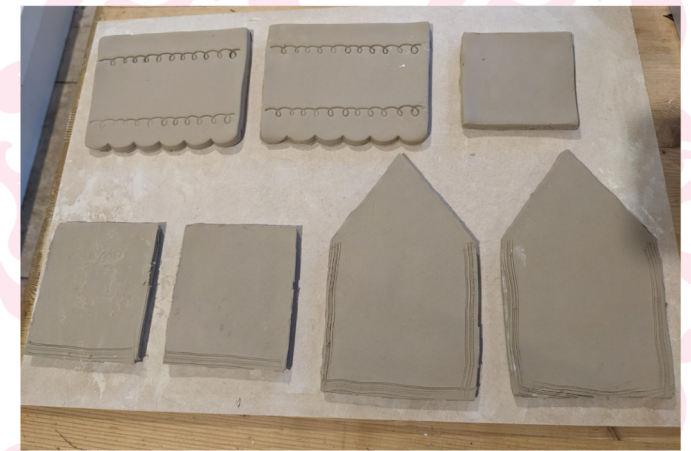

1. Roll clay to around 7mm thick. Cut out a front and back, 2x walls, 2x roof, and 1 base



2. Stamp your design into each piece. The walls need to be portrait orientation



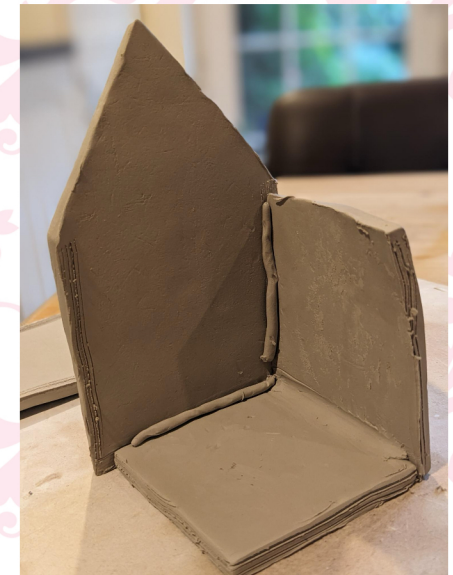
3. Flip over the front, back, and walls, and score where shown. Score all edges of the base piece



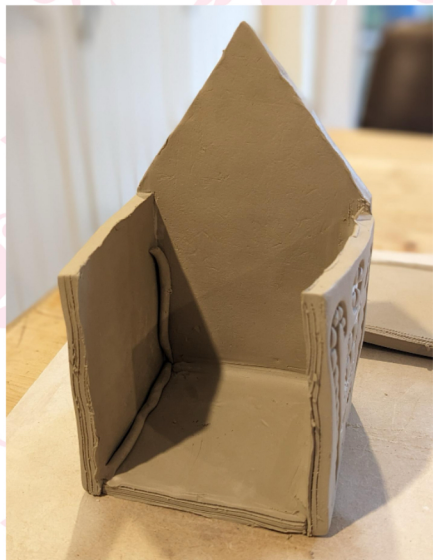
4. Lay out a front and a wall piece (check it's the right way up). Put slip on the areas you have scored



5. Stand up your wall piece against the base. Secure with a sausage of clay and blend this in



6. Attach the front piece in the same way



7. Repeat the previous step to add the second wall...



8. And again to add the back wall



9. Blend in so the joints are nicely sealed



10. Blend in all seams around the outside



11. And on the base



12. Score along the pointy bits where you're going to attach the roof



13. Paint slip on the score lines, place one roof piece onto the house, then take it off again. The slip will leave marks where you need to score



14. Stick your first roof piece on and secure on the inside with a sausage of clay



15. Place on your second roof piece, making sure they meet at the top



16. Add a sausage of clay to the point of the roof and blend in



17. Smooth
the top



18. Score and
slip balls of
clay to the top
for decoration



19. Finally fettle your completed
gingerbread house with a damp paintbrush,
and enjoy!
