



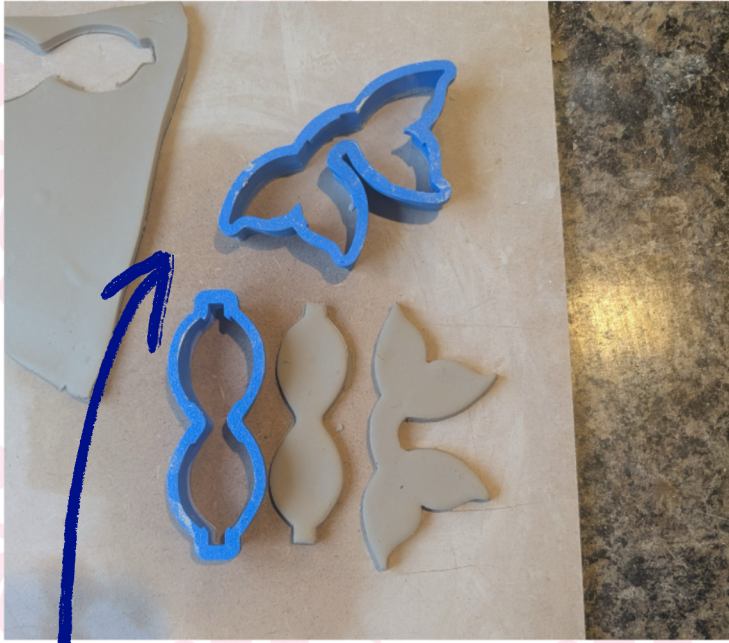

Cutters For Clay

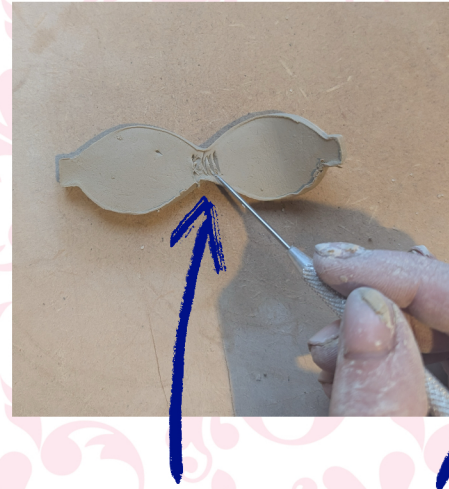

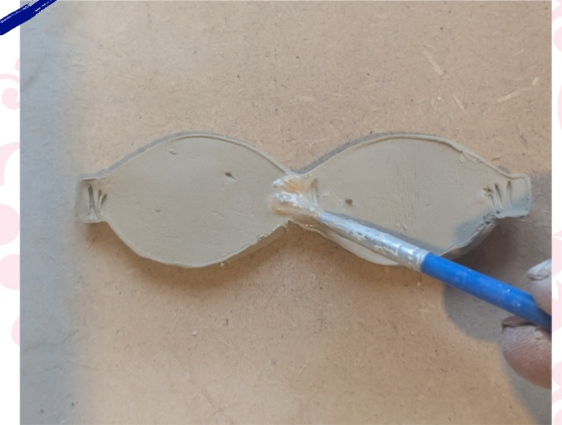
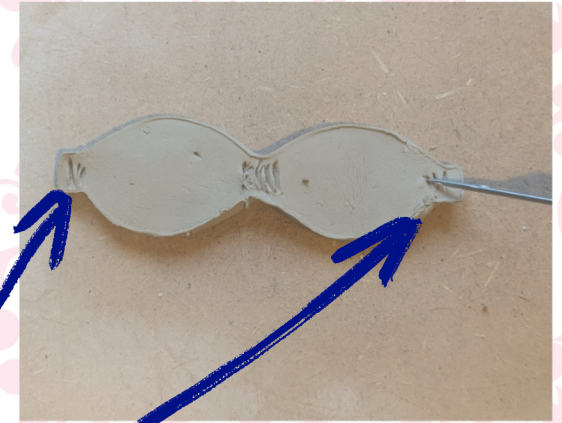
1. Roll your clay to around 3-5mm thick. (You'll need thinner clay for small bows and thicker clay for the large ones)



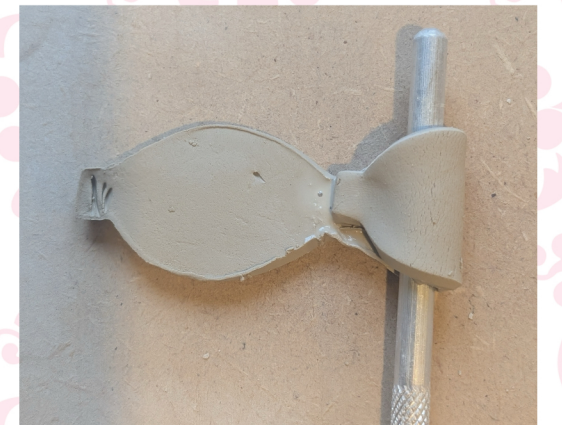
2. Use the 2 part bow cutter set to cut out your clay



3. Working on the middle part, score the areas shown and add a dollop of slip to the middle



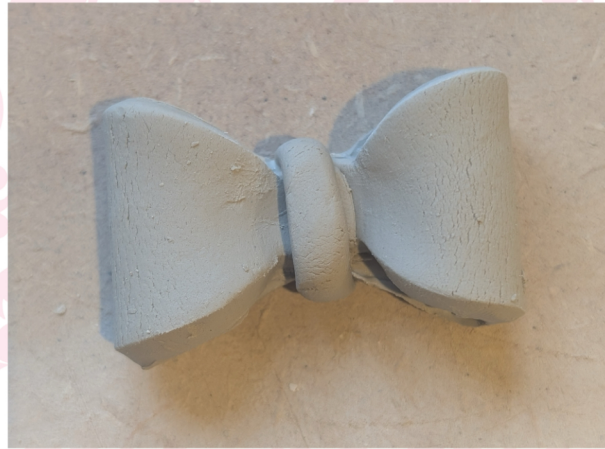
4. Use the handle of a paint brush to help roll the side of the bow over to the middle



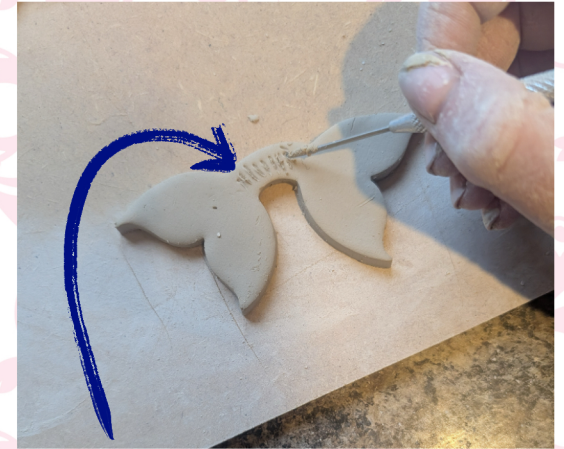




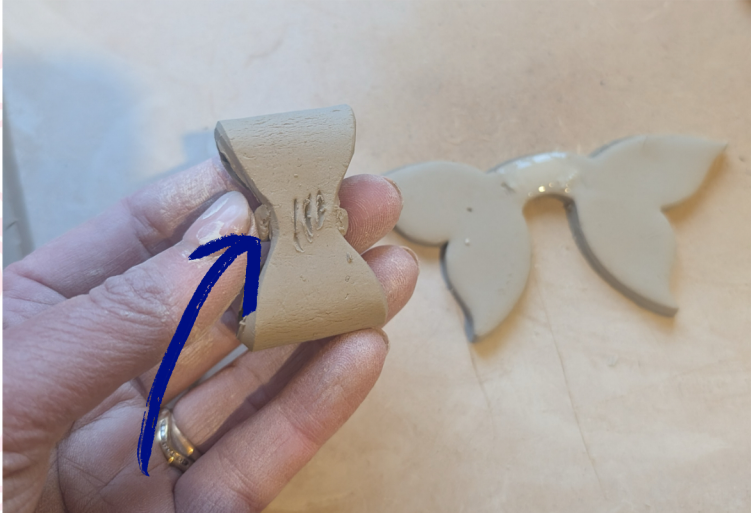
5. Repeat step 4 on the other side and smooth down



6. Wrap a small sausage of clay around the middle of the bow to hide the join and make it pretty



7. Score the middle of the 'tails' piece



8. Score the back of the bow and add a dollop of slip to the 'tails' piece where you have scored



9. Stick the 2 pieces together. Fettle all over with a damp paintbrush then leave to dry slowly before firing
