

Make a Candle Holder with me...

Cutters For Clay

1. Roll your clay to 7mm thick



- 2. Cut out a circle of clay the size of your choice here we have used a 10cm circle cutter
- 3. Score a small circle in the middle of your circle of clay

4. Cut a strip of clay to make the part that holds the candle in place. Here we have used our rolling spacers to cut around to get a nice straight edge





5. Form the strip of clay into a cylinder shape. Score and slip the ends together.

Make this the correct size to fit a candle but make sure you allow for shrinkage



6. Blend the seams together with a small sausage of clay the score the bottom of the cylinder



7. Paint on slip to the scored areas



8. We've added a bow to ours but you can add whatever you like! Just don't forget to score and slip everything in place



9. Fettle all over with a damp paintbrush then leave to dry and tadah!
