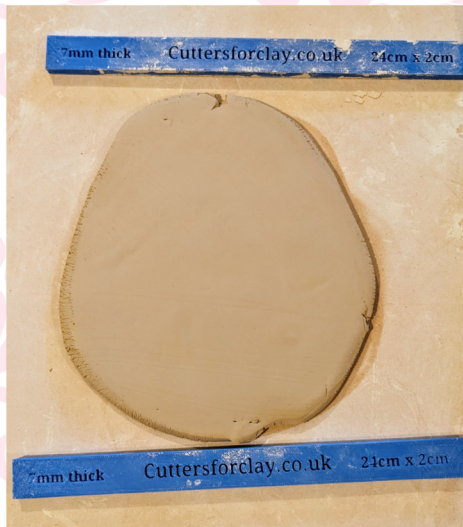


Make a Little Plate For Mini Eggs with me...

1. Roll out your clay to 7mm thick - we've used our handy clay spacers to help



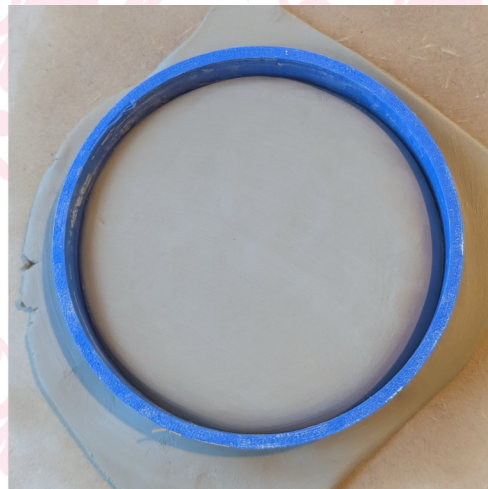
2. Dust your mould with talc or cornflour and lay handle side down



3. Drape your clay over the mould



4. Firm the clay around the mould with your hands then use a damp sponge to smooth out the shape



5. Dust your cutter then place over the mould & cut your clay. Leave the cutter in place for now



6. Flip over the mould, cutter and clay & press the cutter up & over



7. Very gently, smooth over the edges of your trinket dish with a damp sponge



8. Give the mould a little twist & lift away from the clay



9. Neaten your edges again with the damp sponge



10. Place your trinket dish on a flat surface, where it will eventually dry



11. Dust your 'little plate of mini eggs' stamp with talcon powder or corn flour and stamp into the middle of the plate. Carefully lift up the stamp to reveal the design



12. Stamp in a name to make your plate eggs-tra special!



13. Use a paintbrush or needle tool to mark in an apostrophe



14. Rub out any marks from the stamp gently with your finger



15. To avoid any warping during drying, place a small board or tile on top & check regularly while drying to ensure the shape remains the same



16. Ta-dah! Time to fill with mini eggs!
