

Make a Scraffito Bear with me...

1. Roll out your clay to 1cm thick then dust your stamp and cutter set with talc or corn flour. Stamp and cut out your bear face and neaten up the edges with a needle tool. This scraffito technique works best on clay that has firmed up for half an hour or so after rolling out



4. Flood your design with paint as you wish. Flooding the area rather than brushing the paint ensures you get a strong and even coverage



2. Paint any small indented areas/lines now and wipe off the excess



5. Make sure there is plenty of paint on your bear's face



3. Pop some paint onto a scrap piece of clay so you can practice your scraffito marks





6. Practice some scraffito marks on your painted scrap of clay. Experiment with different tools and designs. Then start the design on your bear



8. Leave your bear as it is to dry or slump into a paper bowl or dish of your choice to make a bowl



7. Here's another design we've done...the options are endless!



9. Once your bear is completely dry, bisque fire and then glaze and fire again
