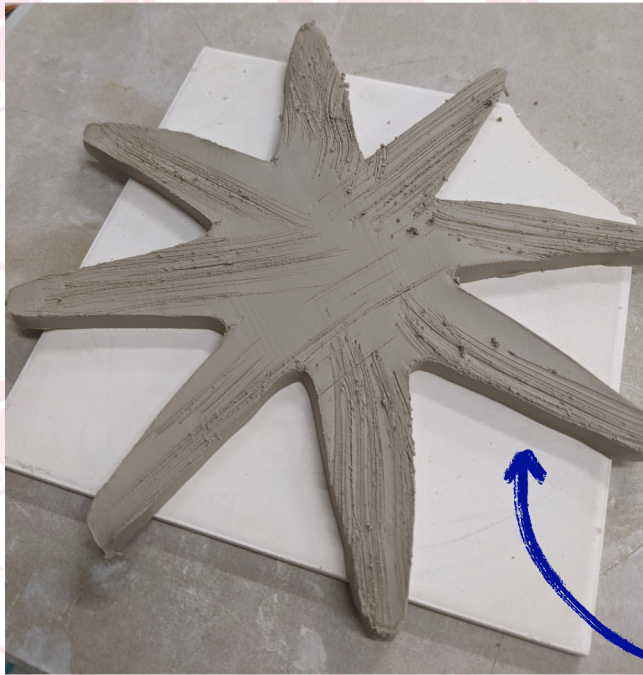


Make an Octopus with me...

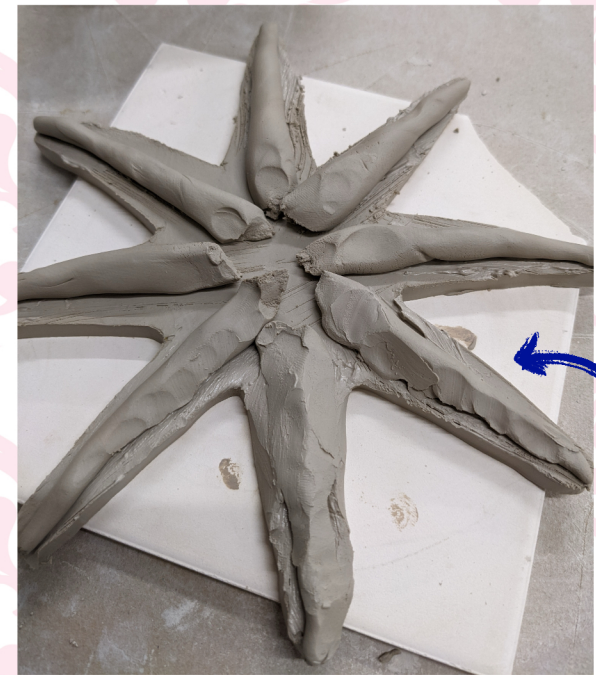


Cutters For Clay

1. Roll out your clay nice and thick to approximately 1cm. Use your cutter to cut out the legs of your octopus then score down the length of each leg and paint on slip



2. Roll out 8 thick sausages of clay about the length of the legs. Firm them into place where you have scored and slipped



3. Smooth out the sausages of clay into your cut out base to create the shape of the legs of your octopus. You can start to manipulate the shape of the legs as you want, giving them pointed ends and lifting them up



4. Make a pinch pot for the face of your octopus. Score and slip the middle of the legs piece and the base of the face and firm into place



5. Add a tongue and eyes and shape the face of your octopus as you wish. We've used the end of a paintbrush to create suckers underneath our octopus' legs



6. Give your octopus some character! Just remember to score and slip anything you add to your octopus



7. Tah-dah! Here's your cheeky octopus! Leave to dry completely on a bisque tile then fire
