

Make a Beach Hut with me...

Cutters For Clay



1. Roll out your clay to 7mm thick. We've used our handy clay spacers to help!



2. Add texture to your rolled out clay. Here we've used our stripes rolling pin, or you could use the side of one of our clay spacers




3. Use your cutters to cut out 1 front, 1 back, 2 walls, 1 base, 2 roof pieces and a door



4. Flip over the front, back and walls and score as shown. Score all edges of the square base. Roll out 4 long and 4 short sausages of clay



5. Paint slip onto the scored areas of 1 wall and a front/back piece and stand them up against the base. Use sausages of clay to secure the joins



6. Smooth out half the sausage of clay into the base and half into the joining wall.

Repeat this where the wall and front/back piece meet



7. Repeat this process to add your second wall and then the second front/back piece.
Remember to add slip to the scored areas before joining together. Blend in all the internal joins



8. Blend in all the seams on the outside of your beach hut...



9. ...and around your base so that everything is nicely blended



10. Score along the points of the front and back and add slip



11. Gently place one roof piece onto your hut then take it off again. The slip will leave marks showing you were to score



14. Repeat steps 11 and 12 with your second roof piece.
Add a sausage of clay to the point of the roof and blend in



12. Score the roof piece and firm into place



15. Check to make sure all joins are nicely blended



13. Secure your first roof piece in place with a sausage of clay inside



16. Now decorate as you wish! Attach the door and any other accessories! Just remember to score and slip anything you add to your hut. Enjoy!
