Cutters For Clay

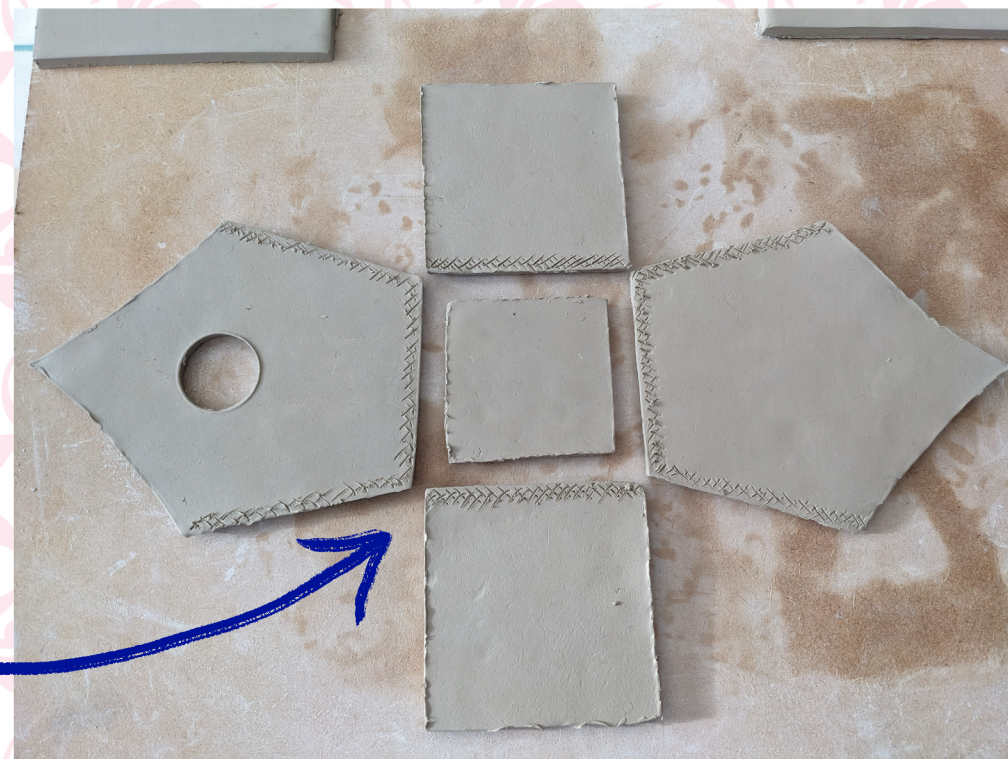

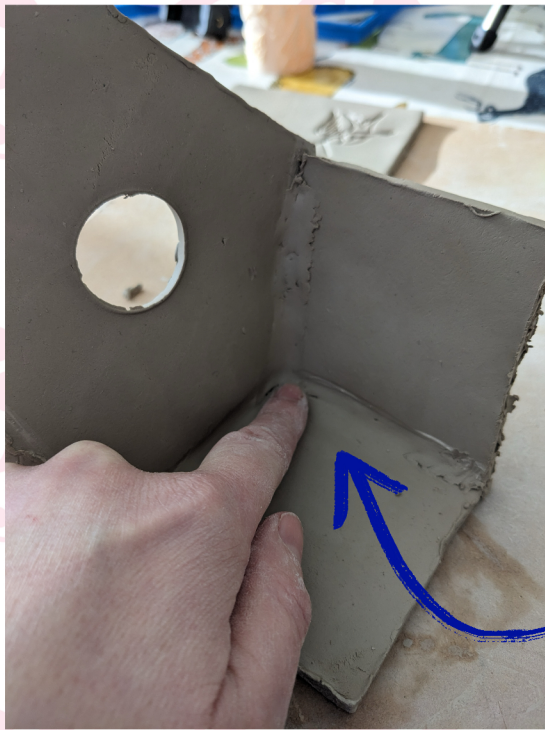


1. Roll out your clay to 7mm thick. We used our handy clay spacers to help! Add texture to your clay as you wish before using your cutters to cut out 2 face pieces, 2 side pieces, 1 base piece and 2 roof pieces. Cut a small circle out of your front face piece

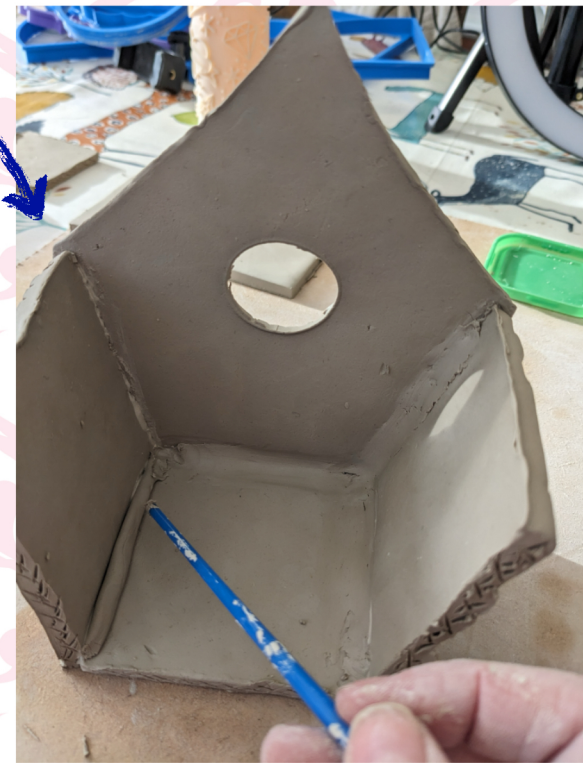
2. Lay out your base, sides, front and back pieces and score the sides like shown here. Paint slip onto the scored edges







3. Roll out a sausage of clay and blend into the joins as you piece your bird house together. Repeat this process until you have all your sides on



4. Blend the joins on the outside of your birdhouse too.

All that's left to do now is add on your roof. Score and slip the apex edges of your front and back pieces and gently lay on the roof pieces. Take your roof pieces back off. There will be a slip mark showing you where to score and slip. Firm your roof pieces in place and smooth out where they join together and where they join to the house.



5. Ta-Dah! Now you have your bird house! Personalise it with any additional decor as you wish. Here's a few ideas...just remember to score and slip any additional pieces you add
