



1. Roll out your clay to 7mm thick.
We've used our clay spacers to help! Then use the cutters to cut out a body, a head and paws




2. Here we've painted the tail section first, making sure to leave the area where the face will be added



3. Score the face area on the body piece and the back of the face piece and paint on slip



4. Add on your face piece and firm into place



5. Using a needle tool, roughly outline where the paws will sit, score a triangle in each ear and outline where you will attach a nose. Here we've made a heart nose! We've used an extruder to make the eyes and whiskers, but if you don't have one, just roll out some thin sausages of clay



6. Paint your cat's face, making sure to avoid the areas you've marked for the ears, nose and paws. Score and slip the back of your paws piece and nose and score the unpainted area on your cat



7. Firm the nose, paws, and clay for the whiskers and eyes and in place. Finish painting your cat and adding any extra detail then... ta-dah!
