

Make a Half Sphere with me...

Cutters For Clay

1. Roll out your clay to 7mm thick. It's best to use slightly firmer clay so it holds its shape easier



2. Powder your dome with talc or corn flour. We're using the 7cm dome here - smaller domes are easier to make than large ones! For larger domes, use slightly thicker clay



3. Brush your clay with talc or corn flour too so it doesn't stick to the dome




4. Drape your clay over the dome mould



5. Firm the clay around the mould



6. Press the cutter down over the mould



7. Cut away and remove any excess clay



8. Turn over your dome and cutter and lift the cutter off



9. Tidy up the edges and give the dome a little twist to release the clay then lift out



10. Decorate your half sphere as you wish... add bits on and cut bits away. Have fun and don't forget to score and slip any clay that you attach
