Seashell Scenes Equipment List

- clay
- a pair of rolling spacers
- rolling pin
- needle tool
- cheese wire
- ball of clay to make a slip pot
- needle tool or pointed spatula
- small pot of water
- paint brushes
- foam sheet/board
- kitchen roll
- paint
- pallet
- silicone moulds
- seashell stamp and cutter set
- pot of baby powder
- fluffy brush





1. Your clay project station should be set up something like this...



2. Use a fluffy brush to lightly dust the design side of the shell stamp with baby powder



3. Place the stamp face down onto your 7mm thick rolled out clay and press down all over



4. Carefully lift up the stamp. The baby powder should prevent the clay from sticking



5. Line up the shell cutter over the stamp design and press down firmly into the clay



6. Leave the cutter in place and tear away the excess clay



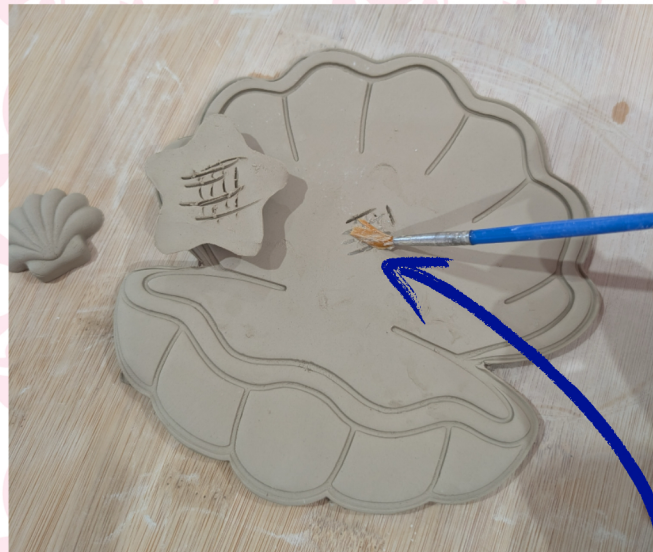
7. Once you've removed the excess clay, slowly lift the cutter away, gently pressing down on the clay as you go



8. Use a needle tool or pointed spatula to tidy up the edges of your cut clay



9. Use the silicone moulds to make any extra clay decorations you'd like to add to your seashell creation



10. Remember to score and apply slip to any extras you are adding to ensure they are firmly attached



11. Use a slightly damp paintbrush to seal any joints and smooth out the edges
