



Make a 3D Wreath with me...

Cutters For Clay

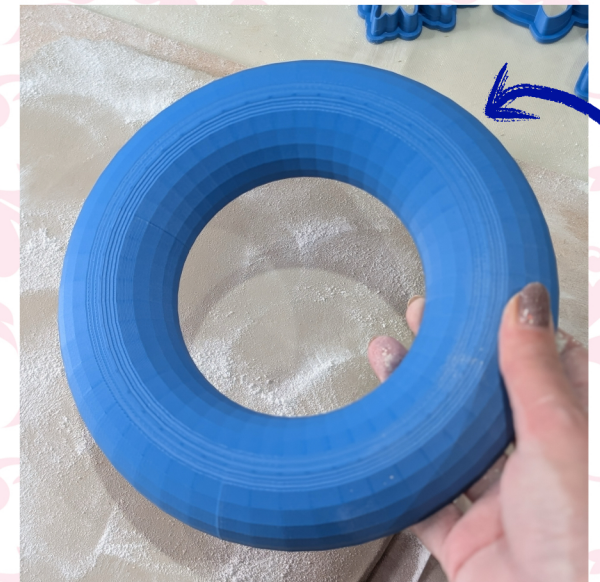

1. Roll out your clay to 7mm thick using our handy clay spacers



2. Dust you clay with baby powder and a fluffy brush to stop the mould from sticking



3. Take your wreath mould and place it flat onto your workspace



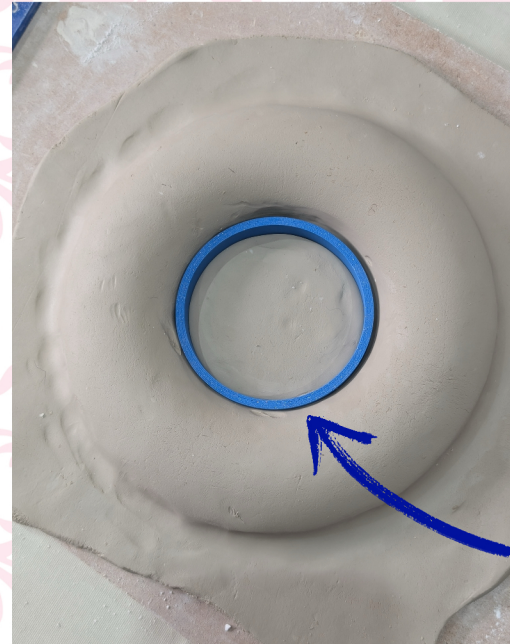
4. Lay the clay over the wreath mould, baby powder side down



5. Use your fingers to gently firm the clay around the mould to make the weath shape



6. Continue smoothing the clay completely around the mould until it looks like this



7. Use the smaller circle cutter to cut out the centre of your wreath

8. Gently remove the cutter and the clay from the centre of your wreath



9. Cut around the wreath with the large circle cutter. Leave the cutter in place and tear away the excess clay



10. After removing the excess clay, turn over your wreath to remove the large cutter to give a smooth edge



11. Use a slightly damp sponge to smooth out your wreath, including the edges where you removed the circle cutters



12. Decorate your wreath as you wish then let it firm up a little bit before gently removing the mould. Don't let it dry fully on the mould as it will crack the clay



13. Remember to score and slip any decor you choose to add - we love using our silicone moulds for this! Check out some of our designs for inspiration
